Speaker Biographies

Abdul Chohan: The Future is Not What it Used to be

Co-Founder Of The Olive Tree School, Bolton, UK and Director of Think Simple Ltd

Abdul Chohan is a teacher of 17 years and is the Founder and Director of Development for The Olive Tree Education Trust in Bolton, UK. He was the former Principal and CEO of the Essa Foundation Academies Trust based in the UK. He is known for his pioneering work on mobile based learning at Essa Academy, Bolton, UK. Since then, he has worked with a number of international educational organisations as well as devising learning strategies based on mobile technology platforms.

In addition to this he is also the Director of ThinkSimple Ltd which is a thought leadership organisation that provides support to schools and Ministries of Education, in terms of Vision and implementation.

His programmes focus on the idea of 'Changing Belief" through 'Simplicity and Reliability' and have extended beyond the traditional school environment to impact families and the wider communities that the schools serve.

Isabella Byrne: The Fusion of Education and AI for Smarter Governance

Head of Governance & Compliance (DPO) at the Diocese of Salisbury Academy Trust (DSAT) and an Accredited Leader for Church School Governance.

Isabella has spent nearly 20 years in education and governance, and 10 years in technical support and database design. She is passionate about how AI and Generative AI can improve education management. In her current leadership role at a large multi-academy trust, Isabella has led innovative projects that use advanced technology to improve administrative tasks:

- Automated Workflows: Simplified the process of onboarding new governors.
- Generative AI: Transformed minute-taking and enhanced communication.
- Data Analytics: Enabled trustees and local academy committees to make data-driven decisions. Isabella's work shows the incredible potential of combining education and technology. Her innovations with AI and automation help to:
- Improve governance efficiency.
- Develop forward-thinking educational strategies.
- Save costs, especially important during budget constraints.

This presentation will explore how AI solutions are changing educational leadership, providing a glimpse into the future of smart, efficient, and responsive governance.

Emma Balchin: Insights from NGA research: reflecting on the recruitment, retention and wellbeing of those who govern

Emma has over 25 years' experience in education, leadership and school improvement. She has significant experience in maintained school and academy governance, both in mainstream settings, and for a PRU and SEMH special school, and has served as an Interim Executive Board (IEB) member.

Emma was appointed Co-CEO alongside Emma Knights in September 2023 and takes the substantive role from September 2024. Prior to this Emma was Director of Professional Development at NGA, a post she held from 2018.

Emma has 12 years of experience working for a local authority, where she supported the provision of services for schools, including the management of governor services, a successful clerking service and delivering the city-wide provision of governor training.

NAGAS will charge each region collectively for the total number of delegates booked from the region. Each regional group will then manage the recharges to each LA/organisation through locally agreed arrangements.


The conference is open to all NAGAS regional members and as places are limited, bookings will be made on a first come, first served basis.







Using public transport




If you are using public transport to get to the conference, you could use this planner to help you get around Milton Keynes




Nearest train stations to Conference




Bus Stops near the Conference

If you are a conference delegate and have received a discount code, please enter this into the 'Search by code, town or postcode section' to obtain reduced rates.




4. Select Vehicle
